International Race Official Certification

Persons interested in becoming certified as an International Race Official Grade 1, are invited to attend the certification course which will be offered at PACCC 2019.

Prospective candidates should refer to the IDBF Competition Regulations Annex A to Competition Regulation 9.6 to determine their eligibility for being assessed and awarded the International Race Official Certificate (IROC).

Prospective candidates must be endorsed by their national federations/associations.

Amendment to Steerspersons Requirements

After careful deliberation and consultation on several relevant factors including but not restricted to safety only, the competition organizers have decided to waive some of the requirements for steerspersons.

This means that for PACCC 2019:

1. **A male steersperson will be allowed to steer for a crew in any Women's racing class.**
2. **There will be no age restrictions for steerspersons in the Senior A, Senior B and Senior C racing classes.**

Registration of Non-competitors

Bulletin 5 will also provide the details for registering non-competitors (managers, coaches, supporters) wishing to receive access accreditation for PACCC 2019.

Ceding for 1000m and 2000m Races

Clubs with crews that will be competing in the 1000m and 2000m races are asked to submit the time(s) recorded by these crews (or crews in the same competition class, belonging to the club) over 500m races at recent festivals or competitions. This will assist in the ceding of crews for the 1000m and 2000m races.
